Screw casters into bottom of Side Frame. Locking caster are put on opposite side of cable wrap.



Lock all casters then tighten by hand.

Install Really Big Tub Frame

Slide Really Big Tub frame into cart frame opposite of cable hooks on Middle Frame

and install safety bolts





Push frame all the way in & then install bolts.

Do not over tighten.





Do not fully tighten hardware until the end of Step 8.




Note orientation of Top Drawer Stretchers. They face front of cart, opposite to the cable hooks on the back.




Install Laptop Tray




